In accordance with the guidelines (EU) 2018/851 on waste and 2018/852 on packaging and packaging waste, all packaging is appropriately labelled in accordance with the procedures established by relevant technical standards and in compliance with the provisions of the European Commission, in order to facilitate the collection, reuse, recovery and recycling of packaging, as well as to provide consumers with correct information on the final disposal of packaging.

In addition, based on Commission Decision 97/129/EC, manufacturers are obliged to indicate the type of packaging materials used for the purpose of labelling and classification of the packaging.
